## A Legacy Asset for Boyd County

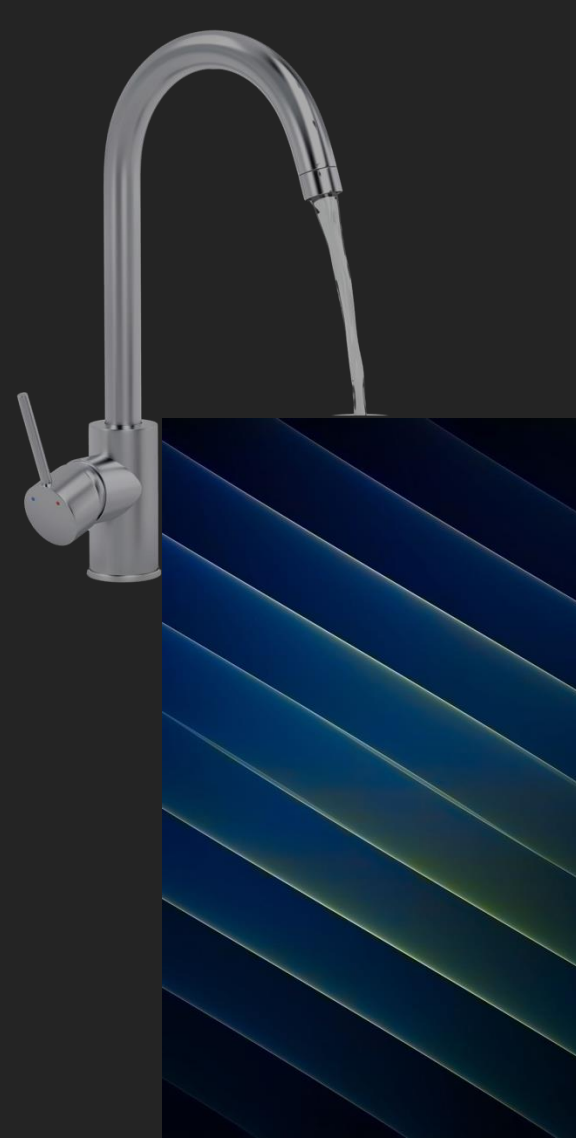
